3 Matters Arising

4 Secretary's Report

See Appendix 1 (Secretary's Report to the 2016/17 Season AGM held on Tuesday 4th April 2017).

The Secretary stated that:

- a. Once again, the Loughborough Branch had held an excellent season of lectures covering all aspects of aerospace historical, present and the future; reminiscences and modern technology.
- b. The average attendance has been **139**. (N.B. This <u>includes</u> the lecture immediately following the AGM and the preceding summer's evening of lectures by Loughborough University's Aeronautical and Automotive Engineering (AeAE) Department's final year MEng students.) This compares with **150** in 2015/16, **168** in 2014/15 and **158** in 2013/14. The slight fall in attendance was probably due to more varied programme incorporating more specialist interests.
- c. There were 4 lectures with other organisations. These organisations were Loughborough University Aeronautical and Automotive Engineering (AeAE) Department, Loughborough University Students' Velocity Society and the Institute of Mechanical Engineering.

5 Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer stated that:

- a. The **Statement of Accounts reflects the situation as of 27th March 2017** and not the date of the AGM, i.e. 4th April 2017.
- b. Only £900 of the Grant from RAeS HQ had been received. The remaining £900 was still awaited.
- c. The Subscriptions from Branch Friends were slightly reduced compared with the 2015/6 season.
- d. The Donations were approximately £100 higher than for the 2015/6 season.
- e. The £504.00 income for members/friends tickets to visit the Shuttleworth Trust on 8th May 2016 is matched by a corresponding figure in Expenditure during the 2015/6 season.
- f. In Expenditure, the nil costs for the Use of Audio-Visual Aids due to the erratic billing timings of Loughborough University's AV Department. As a consequence the corresponding expenditure for the 2017/18 season is likely to be higher.

- g. The 2015/16 Branches Conference and Forum costs of £59.00 compared with £244.75 for the 2015/6 season. The difference is due in part to the dates when payments were due.
- h. The accounts show that the Branch is in a healthy financial situation to start its 2017/18 season's programme.
